Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference (AVDC)

The Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference, initiated by Global Animal Health Partners, LLC, Iowa State University, Kansas State University, South Dakota State University, The University of Georgia, University of Minnesota System, China Agricultural University, Nanjing Agricultural University, is committed to enhancing animal health and food safety through robust veterinary diagnostics. Hosted by The Organizing Committee of the Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference, China Agricultural University, College of Veterinary Medicine, Nanjing Agricultural University, Shixin Lamp International Exhibition (Beijing) Co., Ltd., and AgriA Technology Company Limited, and co-organized by Committee of Experimental Pathology - Shenzhen Experts Unite Association, Open online learning platform for experimental pathology, Sichuan Agricultural University, and the conference has successfully convened five sessions in China, becoming the largest professional gathering in the field of veterinary diagnostics in Asia.

The 5th Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference held from June 24th to 26st, 2024, at Hangzhou International Expo Center, featured 120 guests from over 10 countries including China, the United States, the United Kingdom, the Netherlands, and Australia. In three days, they delivered 128 thematic presentations to 1660 attending delegates, offering a rigorous and professional learning platform. Praised by the industry as a high-quality forum aligned with cutting-edge information, the conference significantly contributes to the advancement and progress of veterinary diagnostics, livestock farming, and food safety.

The 6th Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference is scheduled for June 14-16, 2025, at the Nanjing International Expo Center. Upholding the mission of "Robust diagnostics for enhanced animal health and food safety," the conference will feature authoritative veterinary diagnostic experts from Asia, America, and Europe, presenting the latest developments in global veterinary diagnostics. Topics include experimental pathology, molecular diagnostics, virology/serology, microbiology, certification of veterinary testing, on-site rapid testing, laboratory safety, and laboratory quality management. Attendance is expected to exceed 3000 delegates.

Presentation Formats

Conference Presentations: The conference will feature invited speakers and open submissions. Sessions include pre-conference training, keynote presentations, plenary sessions, and parallel sessions, covering all aspects of veterinary diagnostics related to food animals (swine, cattle, sheep, poultry, aquaculture), experimental animals and pets.

Poster Presentations: The conference provides an opportunity for academics and industry delegates to present posters on topics related to veterinary diagnostics of food animals (swine, cattle, sheep, poultry, aquaculture), experimental animals, pets, and wildlife. Institutions, universities, industry associations, and enterprises are encouraged to participate actively. Student participation in poster presentations is particularly encouraged, with student poster awards available. Poster submissions will close on April 1, 2025, oral submissions will close on March 1, 2025, and posters will be displayed throughout the three-day conference. Detailed instructions on preparing and submitting posters will be provided.

Student Poster Awards: The conference will grant Student Poster Awards. A judging committee will select first, second, and third place winners from submitted student posters, with certificates and cash prizes awarded.
