Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference (AVDC)

The Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference, initiated by Global Animal Health Partners, LLC , University of Minnesota System , Iowa State University , Kansas State University , South Dakota State University , The University of Georgia , China Agricultural University , Nanjing Agricultural University, is committed to enhancing animal health and food safety through robust veterinary diagnostics. Hosted by the Organizing Committee of the Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference, China Agricultural University, College of Veterinary Medicine, Nanjing Agricultural University, National Key Laboratory of Veterinary Public Health and Safety, Shixin Lamp International Exhibition (Beijing) Co., Ltd., and co-organized by Sichuan Agricultural University, Pathology Equipment Branch of China Association of Medical Equipment, Open online learning platform for experimental pathology, Key Laboratory of Animal Epidemiology and Zoonosis, Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, and the conference has successfully convened six sessions in China, becoming the largest professional gathering in the field of veterinary diagnostics in Asia.

The 6th Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference held from June 14th to 16th, 2025, at Nanjing International Exhibition Center, featured 111 guests from China, United States, Brazil, Thailand, Vietnam and so on. Delivered 120 thematic presentations to 1061 attending delegates. The conference spotlighted the latest scientific breakthroughs, cutting-edge technological innovations, and a wide range of practical application cases in the field of veterinary testing and diagnosis, facilitating comprehensive and in-depth discussions. The event featured an opening ceremony with keynote speeches, 9 pre-conference workshops, 12 conference sessions, and culminated in a student oral presentation and poster awards ceremony.

The 7th Annual Veterinary Diagnostic Conference is scheduled for June 24th-26th, 2026, at the Zhengzhou International Convention & Exhibition Center. Upholding the mission of "Robust diagnostics for enhanced animal health and food safety", the conference will feature authoritative veterinary diagnostic experts from Asia, America, and Europe, presenting the latest developments in global veterinary diagnostics. Topics include experimental pathology, molecular diagnostics, virology/serology, microbiology, certification of veterinary testing, on-site rapid testing, laboratory safety, and laboratory quality management. Attendance is expected to exceed 2,000 delegates.

Presentation Formats

Conference Presentations: The conference will feature invited speakers and open submissions. Sessions include pre-conference training, keynote presentations, plenary sessions, and parallel sessions, covering all aspects of veterinary diagnostics related to food animals (swine, cattle, sheep, poultry, aquaculture), experimental animals and pets.

Poster Presentations: The conference provides an opportunity for academics and industry delegates to present posters on topics related to veterinary diagnostics of food animals (swine, cattle, sheep, poultry, aquaculture), experimental animals, pets, and wildlife. Institutions, universities, industry associations, and enterprises are encouraged to participate actively. Student participation in presentations and poster are particularly encouraged, with student oral presentations and poster awards available. Poster submissions will close on April 1st, 2026, oral submissions will close on March 1st, 2026, and posters will be displayed throughout the three-day conference. Detailed instructions on preparing and submitting posters will be provided.

Student Oral Presentation and Poster Awards: First, Second, and Third-place awards were conferred by the Conference Awards Committee upon selected student oral presentations and posters, based on a rigorous review process. The winners will receive certificates and monetary prizes.

Asian Expo for Veterinary Medicines and Equipment

With changes in global farming practices, ecological environments, and the accelerating process of global
